Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka (PUCSL) was established by the Act No. 35 of 2002 as a multi sector infrastructure regulator in the country. With the enactment of the Sri Lanka Electricity Act No. 20 of 2009, the Commission became the economic, safety and technical regulator of the Electricity Industry. As the electricity regulator, protection of the interests of consumers is one of the prime objectives of the Commission. To meet that objective, PUCSL has established a Consumer Consultative Committee (CCC) to advise the Commission on protection of consumer interests.

Applications are called from permanent residents in relevant Provinces, who are keen in consumer protection and willing to be committed as members of the CCC.

Candidate Requirements:

- Less than 65 years of age, as at the date of this notice
- Proven interest in community / social service (preferably in consumerism);
- Working knowledge in English is preferable, in addition to Sinhala / Tamil
