The Securities and Exchange Commission of Sri Lanka (SEC) was established by an Act of Parliament No. 36 of 1987 as amended, to regulate the Securities Market in the country and is coming under the purview of the Ministry of National Policies and Economic Affairs. Its primary objectives include the creation and maintenance of a fair and orderly Securities Market; ensuring professional standards are maintained in the industry and the protection of the interest of investors. It is also responsible to facilitate the development of the Capital Market.

The SEC invites applications from self motivated, energetic, dynamic team players with proven integrity, leadership skills, strong interpersonal skills and ability to maintain confidentiality along with a positive attitude to the following position:

DIRECTOR - CAPITAL MARKET EDUCATION AND TRAINING

The Director Capital Market Education and Training will be overall responsible for the smooth functioning of the Capital Market Education and Training arm (CMET) of the SEC and major responsibilities inter-alia include:

- Formulation of study courses/curricula,
- Identification of resource personnel appropriate to the CMET,
- Conduct of lectures on capital market related subjects,
- Coordination with resource personnel to conduct lectures/programmes,
- Continuous upgrade of the quality of all programmes as an ongoing exercise.

The candidate should:

- Possess a Bachelors Degree in Finance, Economics, Accountancy, Commerce, Mathematics, Engineering, Physical Sciences, Business Administration or any other discipline with a Class from a recognised University or Attorney at Law with a Class or a Member of a recognised professional accounting body or be a Charter holder of the Chartered Financial Analyst Institute of USA. Preference will be given to candidates who possess Masters/PhD,
- Possess a demonstrable track record of at least 10 years of relevant experience at senior managerial and managerial level with academic background at a recognised University or Educational Institution. Exposure to Capital / Financial markets will be a distinct advantage,
- Be articulate, analytical and decisive with excellent oral and written skills in English, Sinhala and/or Tamil and be computer literate. Candidate should be between 35-55 years of age.

The position offers an excellent working environment along with a remuneration package in keeping with the qualifications and experience of the successful candidate.

Candidates from Government Agencies could be considered on secondment basis and the maximum age will not be applicable.
