The World Bank assisted Water Supply and Sanitation Improvement Project (WaSSIP) is designed to increase access to piped water services and improve sanitation in Mullaithivu, Kilinochchi, Nuwara Eliya, Kegalle, Ratnapura, Badulla and Moneragala Districts, and capacity development of Drinking Water Sector Institutions.

The project will directly benefit an estimated 425,000 people with safe piped water supply, covering Urban, Rural and Estate areas (Nuwara Eliya District only).

Further, the augmentation of some existing Rural Water Supply Systems, will improve service delivery in the proposed project areas.

Similarly, the Sanitation Programme will benefit approximately 43,000 families, to build the individual latrines in Rural and Estate areas.

This project would finance the construction of strategically located septage treatment facilities in each of the District, in order to improve sanitation for people in town, and the environmental conditions in the catchment area of these facilities of which the main requirement of the project.

Project Management Unit (PMU) of this Project will be established in Colombo and District Support Units (DSUs) will be established, one in each District. The total project cost is USD 183Mn and the period is five years.
